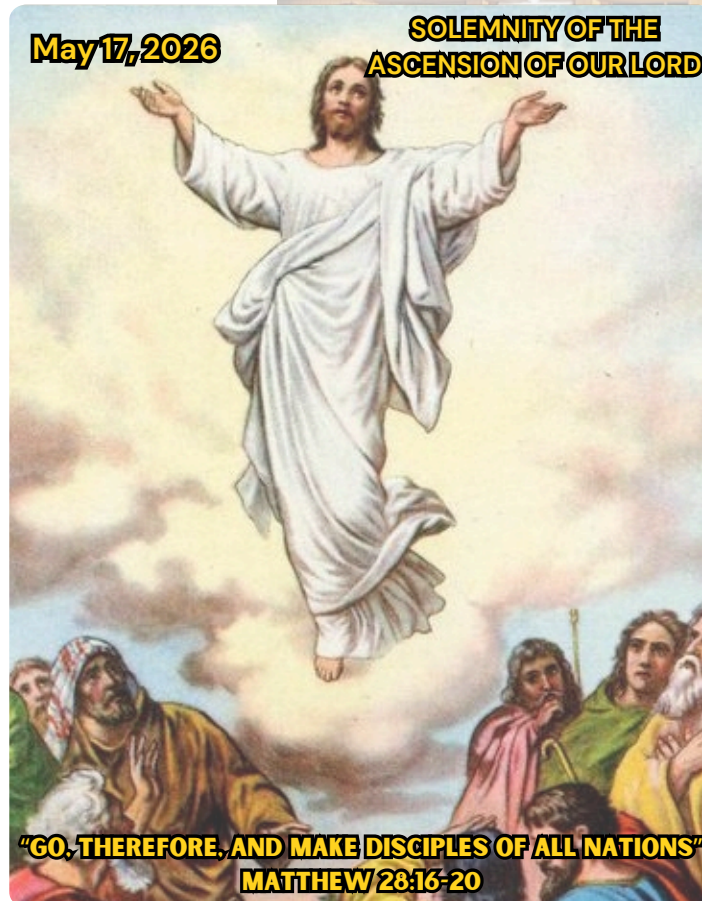

BAPTISMS

Parents must be registered parishioners for a minimum of six months. Please note that appointments are available by appointment only, and preparation classes are required.

FIRST COMMUNION

Students must be enrolled in religious education classes for at least two years and currently attending First Communion class.

CONFIRMATION

Students must be enrolled in religious education classes for at least two years and currently attending Confirmation class.

MARRIAGE

Preparation must begin a minimum of six months before a proposed wedding date at our church or any other church. Dates will be finalized after consultation with the pastor.

Mass Intentions

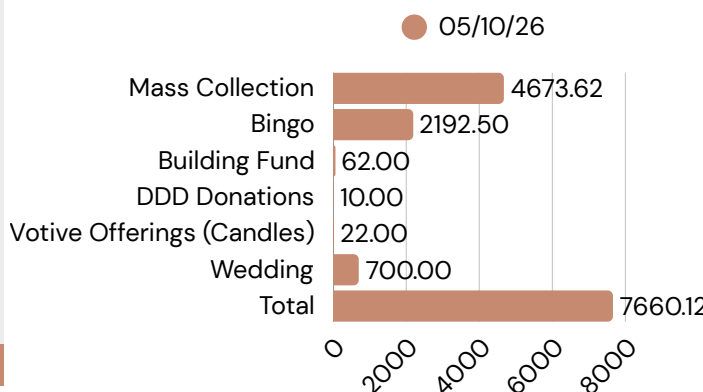

Pastoral Message

Bulletin XXXVIII – The Solemnity of the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ. After His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven because He is God and belongs to the Father. His mission on earth was fulfilled, yet He did not abandon His disciples or leave them orphaned.

Before ascending into heaven, Jesus gave His disciples a mission: “Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.”

This is Good News for all of us. The Ascension is a concrete sign of our hope of heaven. Jesus opened the gates of heaven for humanity, and where He has gone, we hope to follow someday.

The Lord entrusted the Church with the mission of proclaiming salvation to all people. In earlier times, the Church expressed this truth with the phrase *Extra Ecclesiam nulla salus* – “Outside the Church there is no salvation.” This reminds us of the importance of the Church founded by Christ and the mission given to the apostles to preach the Gospel and baptize all nations.

As disciples of Jesus today, we continue this mission not only through words, but also through the witness of our lives. We are called to bring others closer to Christ by living our faith with love, charity, humility, and fidelity to the Gospel.

May the Ascension remind us that our true home is in heaven, and may we continue faithfully the mission entrusted to us by Christ.

Boletín XXXVIII – La Solemnidad de la Ascensión de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo

Hoy la Iglesia celebra la Solemnidad de la Ascensión de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo.
