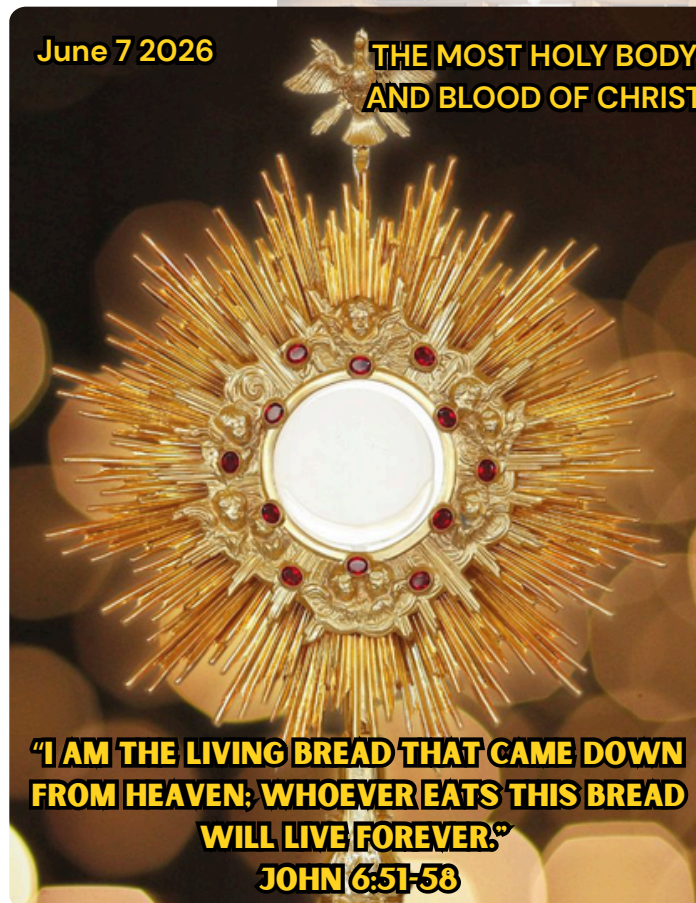

BAPTISMS
Parents must be registered parishioners for a minimum of six months. Please note that appointments are available by appointment only, and preparation classes are required.

FIRST COMMUNION
Students must be enrolled in religious education classes for at least two years and currently attending First Communion class.

CONFIRMATION
Students must be enrolled in religious education classes for at least two years and currently attending Confirmation class.

MARRIAGE
Preparation must begin a minimum of six months before a proposed wedding date at our church or any other church. Dates will be finalized after consultation with the pastor.

Mass Intentions

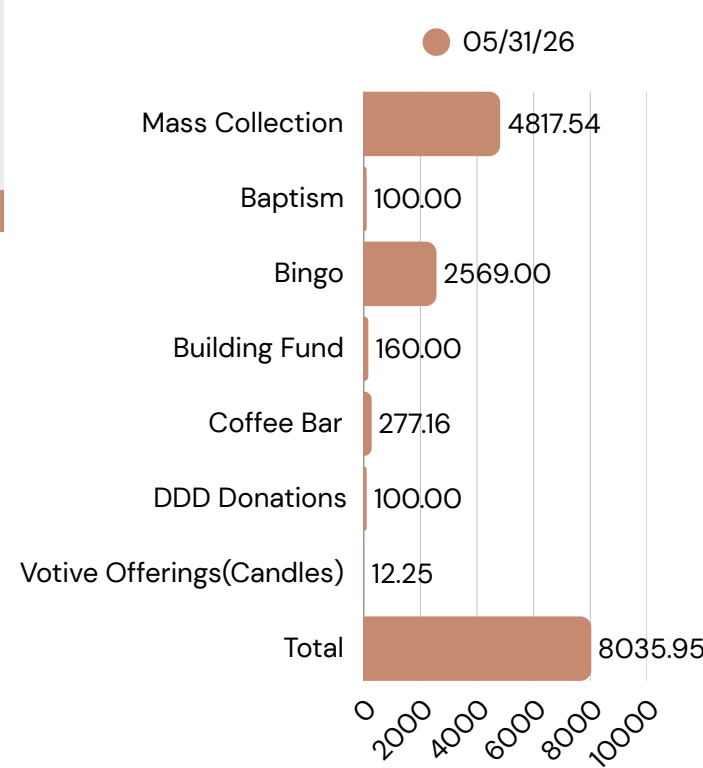

Gospel: John 6:51–58

"My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink." (John 6:55)

Pan de Vida – Cuerpo del Señor

When we celebrate the Holy Eucharist and the priest proclaims, “Take and eat; this is my Body,” and “Take and drink; this is my Blood,” the saving sacrifice of Jesus Christ becomes present among us. The sacrifice of Calvary is made present at every Mass—not in a bloody manner, but under the appearances of bread and wine.

In Holy Communion, we receive Jesus Christ Himself—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. When we answer “Amen” and receive Him worthily, Christ is born in our hearts. As Mary welcomed Jesus into her womb at the Annunciation, we welcome Him into our hearts in the Eucharist. Through this sacred encounter, we grow in sanctifying grace and are united more deeply with Our Lord.

There is no greater gift on earth than receiving Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist. Through Holy Communion, He nourishes our souls, strengthens our faith, increases His life within us, and draws us closer to Him.
