- Landscape work includes cutting down shrubs and dead branches from trees, digging out tree suckers in the back field, raking and cleaning up the parking lot islands, and weeding the flower beds.
- Painting the curbs.
- Cleaning and conditioning the pews and other woodwork.
- Trimming the shrubs and trees around the rectory
- Washing windows.

Volunteers should bring their own gloves, safety glasses, and appropriate footwear. We also ask everyone to bring tools such as chainsaws, rakes, brooms, wheel barrels, and shovels.
