Pastor's Message

Dear Brothers and sisters,

Please take some time this weekend to visit the Fall Craft Fair that is taking place in the Parish Hall. It's a great event for our community and always a good idea to support local small businesses.

It was a great honor for our parish to be recognized as the parish of the year at the Catholic Community Services of Utah Humanitarian Awards earlier this week. Our parish was chosen for the dedicated volunteer support we provide to the St. Vincent de Paul dining hall. My sincere thanks to Dave Mullen for his dedication to this ministry.

Today's Gospel explains how Jesus showed the mercy and compassion of our Heavenly Father by healing Bartimaeus, a blind man. On hearing that Jesus was passing by, Bartimaeus loudly expressed his trusting Faith in the healing power of Jesus by shouting, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" . Each one of us suffers from spiritual blindness. Let us learn to recognize the causes of our spiritual blindness. Anger, hatred, jealousy, evil habits, addictions, sloth etc. make us spiritually blind, and they prevent us from seeing the goodness and presence of God in our lives. Let us learn to think about and see the goodness in others without becoming unkind, critical, or judgmental. Let us approach Jesus in prayer with trusting Faith, as Bartimaeus did, and listen carefully to His voice asking us: "What do you want me to do for you?" Let us tell Him all our heart's intentions and needs.

Aprendamos a pensar y ver la bondad en los demás sin volvernos crueles, críticos o juzgadores. Acerquémonos a Jesús en oración con fe confiada, como lo hizo Bartimeo, y escuchemos atentamente su voz que nos pregunta: "¿Qué quieres que haga por ti?". Contémosle todas las intenciones y necesidades de nuestro corazón.
