Dear Brothers and sisters,

Jesus begins by painting a vivid picture of the end times, emphasizing the upheaval that will precede the coming of the Kingdom. The imagery of a darkened sun and falling stars is not just about cosmic events but also about the world as we know it passing away. It reminds us that everything in this life—our possessions, achievements, even our own physical lives—are temporary.

Yet, while the world may seem unstable and uncertain, we are reminded that God’s Word is unchanging. As Jesus says, “Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.” In a world that can feel chaotic and out of control, we are assured that God’s love and truth remain steady and constant.
