Dear Brothers and sisters,

Today we come to the last Sunday of the 2024 Liturgical year as we celebrate the Solemnity of our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. This Feast was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925, as a reminder to the totalitarian governments of Mussolini, Hitler, and Stalin that Jesus Christ is the only Sovereign King. Pope Pius XI proclaimed: “Pax Christi in regno Christi” (the peace of Christ in the reign of Christ). This means that we live in the peace of Christ when we surrender our lives to Him every day, accept Him as our

God, Savior and King and allow Him to rule our lives. This feast challenges us to see Christ the King in everyone, especially those whom our society considers the least important, and to treat each person with the same love, mercy, and compassion Jesus showed. As loyal subjects (followers) of Christ the King, we are invited to treat others with justice and compassion as Jesus did, when we accept Jesus as the King of our lives, then everything else falls into place.
