Pastor's Message

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In today's Gospel, we witness the call of the first disciples, where Jesus, standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, calls Simon, James, and John to follow Him. After a long, fruitless night of fishing, Jesus asks Simon to cast the nets again, leading to a miraculous catch. Overcome by the abundance of fish, Simon falls to his knees in awe, recognizing his unworthiness. Yet Jesus responds with compassion, telling him, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men."

This passage teaches us a powerful lesson about faith and trust in God. Like the disciples, we often work hard, yet feel empty or unfulfilled. But when we listen to Jesus and trust in His guidance, He can transform our efforts and bring about abundance in our lives—spiritually and otherwise. Jesus calls us, not because we are perfect, but because He desires to use us as instruments of His love and mercy.

In responding to Jesus' call, the disciples immediately leave everything behind to follow Him. Their willingness to step into the unknown with faith is a powerful reminder for us to answer God's call in our own lives. He asks us to trust in His plan, even when it may seem uncertain or difficult. Like the first disciples, we are called to be witnesses of His love and to share that love with others.

Mensaje del pastor

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

En el Evangelio de hoy, somos testigos del llamado de los primeros discípulos, donde Jesús, de pie junto al lago de Genesaret, llama a Simón, Santiago y Juan a seguirlo. Después de una larga e infructuosa noche de pesca, Jesús le pide a Simón que vuelva a echar las redes, lo que lleva a una pesca milagrosa. Abrumado por la abundancia de peces, Simón cae de rodillas con asombro, reconociendo su indignidad. Sin embargo, Jesús responde con compasión, diciéndole: "No tengas miedo; de ahora en adelante serás pescador de hombres".

Este pasaje nos enseña una poderosa lección sobre la fe y la confianza en Dios. Al igual que los discípulos, a menudo trabajamos duro, pero nos sentimos vacíos o insatisfechos. Pero cuando escuchamos a Jesús y confiamos en su guía, Él puede transformar nuestros esfuerzos y generar abundancia en nuestras vidas, espiritualmente y en otros aspectos. Jesús nos llama, no porque seamos perfectos, sino porque desea usarnos como instrumentos de su amor y misericordia.

Al responder al llamado de Jesús, los discípulos inmediatamente dejan todo atrás para seguirlo. Su disposición a adentrarse en lo desconocido con fe es un poderoso recordatorio para que respondamos al llamado de Dios en nuestras propias vidas. Él nos pide que confiemos en su plan, incluso cuando parezca incierto o difícil. Al igual que los primeros discípulos, estamos llamados a ser testigos de su amor y a compartir ese amor con los demás.
