Pastor's Message

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The season of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, March 5th. Masses will be celebrated at 9 am (English) & 6:30 pm (Bilingual). We will also continue the Lenten practice of praying the Stations of the Cross on Friday evenings at 6 pm in English & 7 pm in Spanish beginning Friday, March 7th. The CCW will offer a Lenten soup supper at 6:30 pm in the Parish Hall for \$4/serving to eat in or take out. Please consider supporting their ministry.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The rule of abstinence from meat is binding upon Catholics aged 14 and onwards, and the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 60. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Those who are excused from fasting and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill, including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes, as well as pregnant or nursing women. In all cases, common sense should prevail, and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting.

Ash Wednesday is the beginning of the Holy and Penitential Season of Lent. On this day we acknowledge the truth that we are nothing without God - no more than dust. We admit to our selfishness and greed, which is part of living in this world. All of this would be pretty grim if not for that other Truth - the Truth that the God Who formed us from the dust wishes to reform and revive us. Our Lenten confession is an act of faith and hope in the God Who is love.

Holy Moments for the Spanish-Speaking Community: Begins Sunday, March 9th at 3:00 pm. Books are available for a \$5.00 donation. Plan to attend the first group where you can pick up your book. It is a wonderful book and has proven to provide something meaningful for the Lenten season.

Mensaje del pastor

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

La temporada de Cuaresma comienza con el Miércoles de Ceniza el 5 de marzo. Las misas se celebrarán a las 9 am (inglés) y a las 6:30 pm (bilingüe). También continuaremos con la práctica cuaresmal de rezar el Vía Crucis los viernes por la noche a las 6 pm en inglés y a las 7 pm en español a partir del viernes 7 de marzo. La CCW ofrecerá una cena de sopa de Cuaresma a partir de las 6:30 pm en el Salón Parroquial por \$4 por porción para comer allí o para llevar. Por favor, considere apoyar su ministerio.

El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días obligatorios de ayuno y abstinencia para los católicos. Además, los viernes durante la Cuaresma son días obligatorios de abstinencia. La regla de abstinencia de carne es vinculante para los católicos de 14 años en adelante, y las normas sobre el ayuno son obligatorias desde los 18 años hasta los 60 años. Cuando ayuna, a una persona se le permite comer una comida completa, así como dos comidas más pequeñas que juntas no equivalen a una comida completa. Entre los que están exentos del ayuno y la abstinencia fuera de los límites de edad se encuentran los enfermos físicos o mentales, incluidos los individuos que sufren enfermedades crónicas como la diabetes, así como las mujeres embarazadas o lactantes. En todos los casos, debe prevalecer el sentido común y las personas enfermas no deben poner en peligro aún más su salud con el ayuno.

El Miércoles de Ceniza es el comienzo de la Santa y Penitencial Temporada de Cuaresma. En este día reconocemos la verdad de que no somos nada sin Dios, no somos más que polvo. Admitimos nuestro egoísmo y codicia, que es parte de la vida en este mundo. Todo esto sería bastante sombrío si no fuera por esa otra Verdad: la Verdad de que el Dios que nos formó del polvo desea reformarnos y reavivarnos. Nuestra confesión cuaresmal es un acto de fe y esperanza en el Dios que es el amor mismo.

Momentos Sagrados para la Comunidad Hispana: Comienza el domingo 9 de marzo a las 3:00 p. m. Los libros están disponibles por una donación de \$5.00. Planee asistir al primer grupo, donde podrá recoger su libro. Es un libro maravilloso y ha demostrado ser algo significativo para la temporada de Cuaresma.
