## **Welcome Fr. Rodel Ignacio!**

This weekend, Fr. Rodel joins us as an interim priest for the next three months. He will be with us until July 31, 2025 at which time our unnamed permanent pastor will join us. Fr. Rodel has been assured we have a strong community of faith and that the laity will continue to serve as usual in all of our ministries.

Father Rodel has served in many capacities as a priest over his years including several assignments in Utah. He has spent time at St. Mary's in Park City and Blessed Sacrament in Sandy among other assignments. For the past year, Father Rodel has been in the Philippines and has just recently returned to Utah. He is Filipino and is the youngest of three children in his family. Before being called to the priesthood, he was a businessman. He studied theology at the University of St. Thomas Central in Manila and was ordained to the priesthood in 2008. Along with his priesthood, Fr. Rodel loves sports, especially basketball, and has hinted that he really likes chocolate!

Father Rodel is living in the rectory and will celebrate daily Mass as well as all of the weekend Masses. The parish schedule will remain the same including Mass times, confessions, etc. He is available for anointing the sick and hopes to get on a schedule to visit those who are unable to join us at Mass. He will work with the laity who are currently involved in this ministry.

El P. Rodel ha desempeñado diversos cargos como sacerdote a lo largo de sus años, incluyendo varias asignaciones en Utah. Es filipino y el menor de tres hijos. Antes de ser llamado al sacerdocio, era empresario. Estudió teología en la Universidad de Santo Tomás Central en Manila y fue ordenado sacerdote en 2008. El Padre Rodel vive en la rectoría y celebrará la misa diaria, así como todas las misas de fin de semana.
